INSIDE THIS EDITION 4M Oysters Planted Pres. Jordan Inspires Kayak Winner







September 13, 2015 — Seventeen volunteers came out early Sunday morning to plant over 500 bushels, or about twelve tons, of spaton-shell in the St. Mary's River adjacent to St. Mary's College of Maryland. The oysters were struck in our on-shore nursery during the

months of June and July.

"Our spat-on-shell was more heavily struck than in other years and the oysters will be overcrowded as they grow," said Association Executive Director Bob Lewis, noting that many of the individual shells hosted more than thirty spat (baby oysters). He said that since the planting area was a sanctuary, the densely struck shells would not matter. "As they grow, the clumps of baby oysters push apart from each other."

Students from Great Mills High School STEM Academy with Mr. Skinner joined students from St. Mary's College and community members who worked together and quickly to complete the planting in about two hours. Unfortunately, our photographer showed up just as the planting ended. If any of the participants have photos, we would be pleased if you would share them with us.
